The Norm-Based Scoring of the SF-36® health status profile standardizes each scale to a mean of 50 and a standard deviation of 10 in the general U.S. population.

HEALTH SCORES

Physical Functioning (PF)

Performance of a range of physical activities such as self-care, walking, climbing stairs, and vigorous activities

Role Physical (RP)

Impact of physical health on performance of work or other regular daily activities

Bodily Pain (BP)

Severity of bodily pain and its interference with work inside or outside of the home

General Health (GH)

Evaluations of general health including current health, health outlook, and resistance to illness

Vitality (VT)

Frequency of feeling full of energy versus feeling tired and worn-out

Social Functioning (SF)

Extent and frequency of limitations in social activities with friends/relatives due to health problems

Role Emotional (RE)

The impact of emotional problems on performance of work or other regular daily activities

Mental Health (MH)

Composite measure of anxiety, depression, and loss of behavioral/emotional control versus psychological well-

SUMMARY SCORES

Physical Health Summary (PCS-36)

Physical status, well-being and bodily pain and their impact on role and social activities and rating of general

Mental Health Summary (MCS-36)

Emotional status and its impact on role and social activities; rating of overall health.
